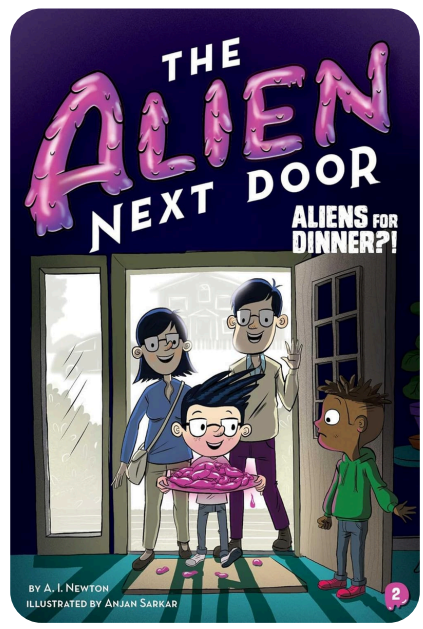


# NOVEMBER KIDS' BOOK BAG BOOK CHOICES

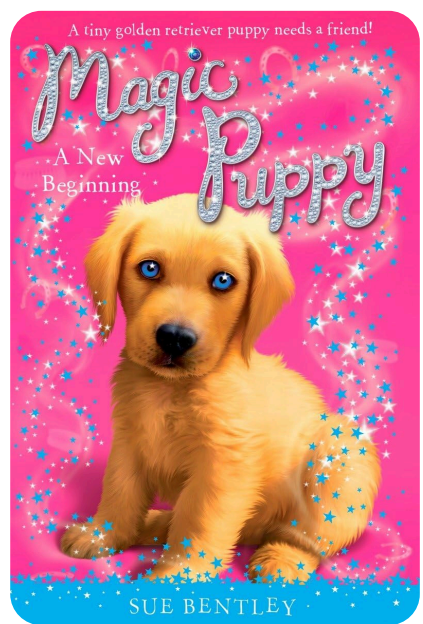

Introduces various kinds of butterflies and discusses their habitat, metamorphosis, life cycle, and defenses. Mike Maydak (Illustrator)

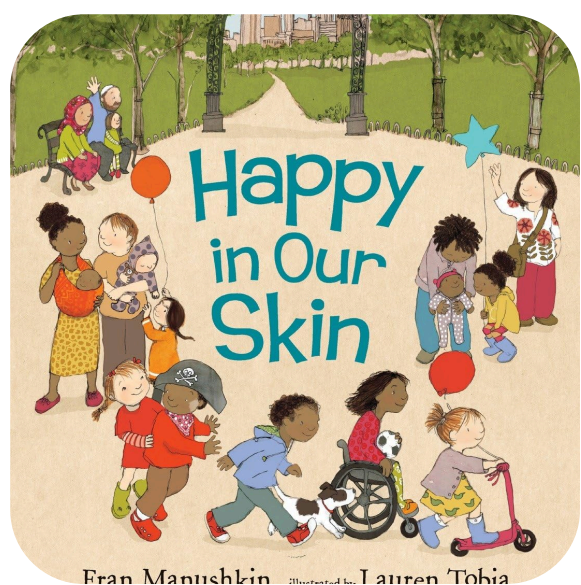

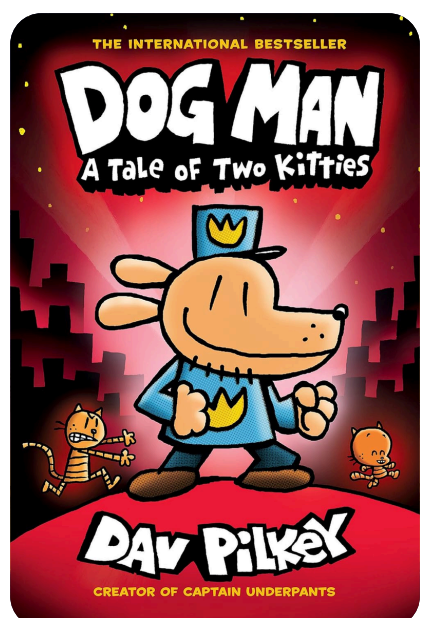


## *Happy in Our Skin* by Fran Manushkin

## *Dog Man: A Tale of Two Kitties* by Dav Pilkey

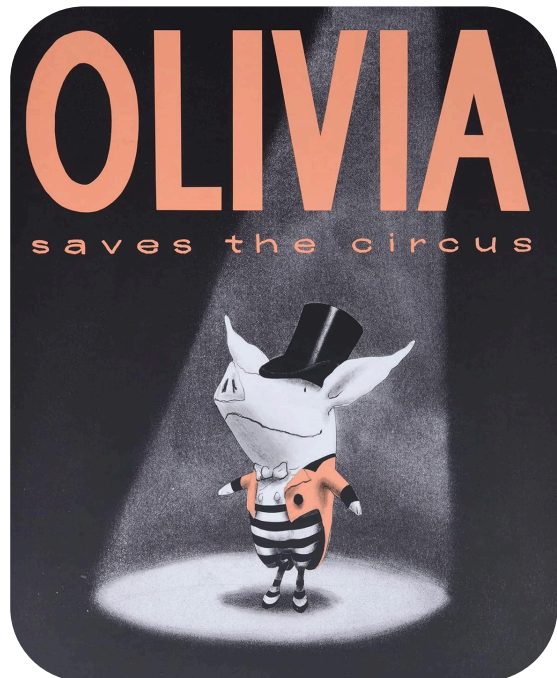
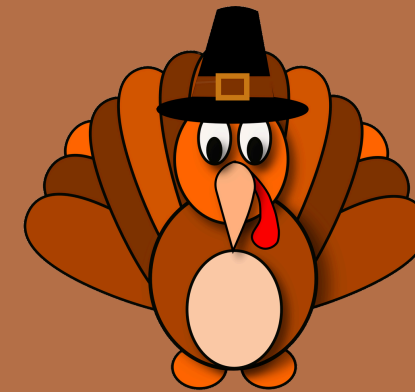

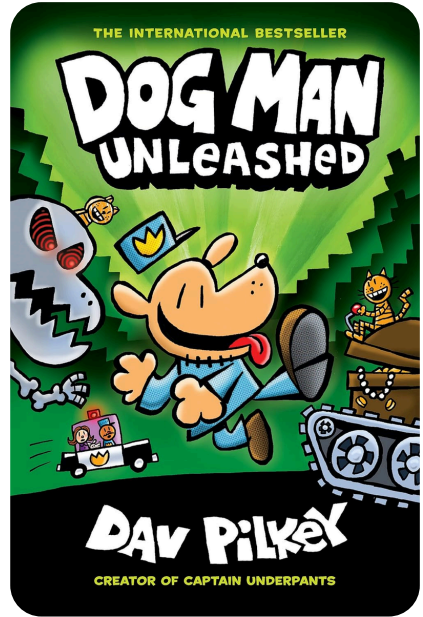
## ***What if You Had T. Rex Teeth?* by Sandra Markle**

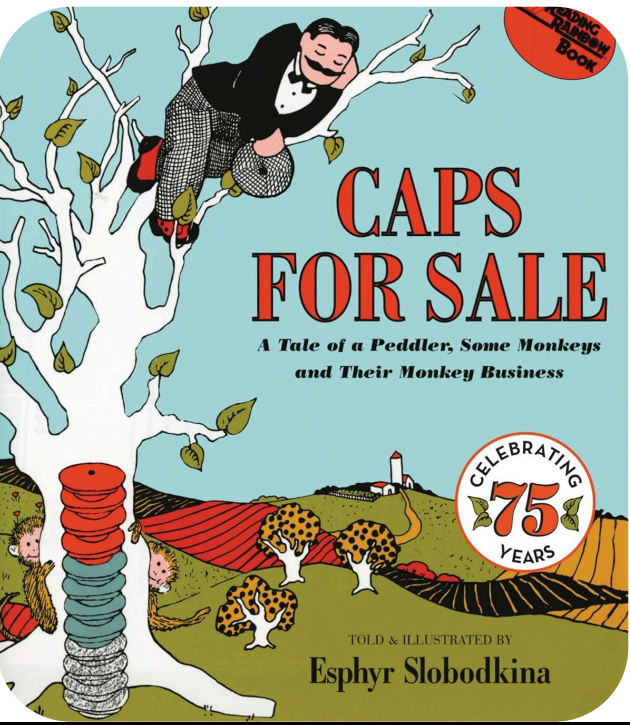
## ***Princess Truly: I Am Super Girl* by Kelly Greenawalt**

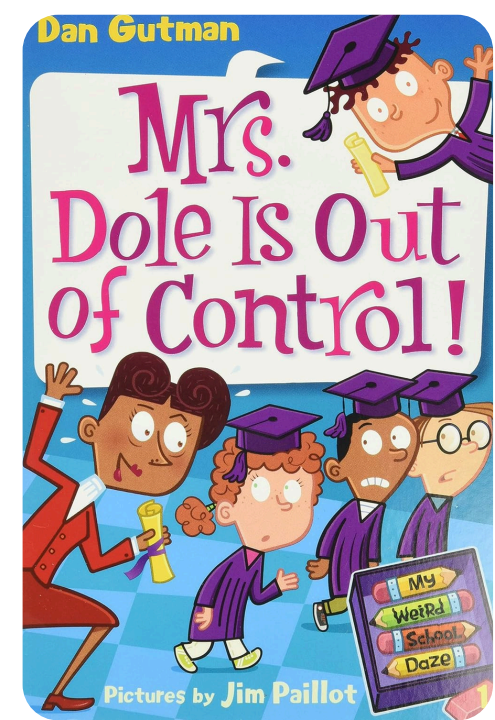
## ***Caps For Sale* by Esphyr Slobodkina**

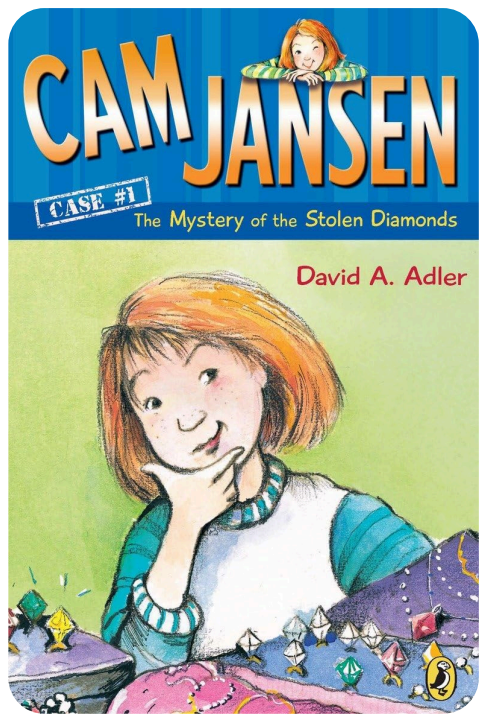
## ***Mrs. Dole is Out of Control* by Dan Gutman**

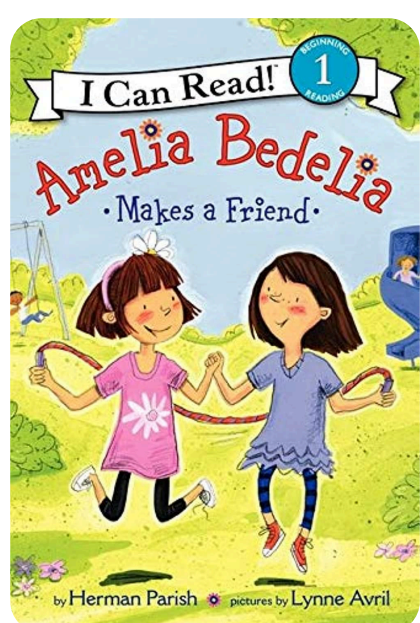
## ***Cam Jansen* by David A. Adler**
