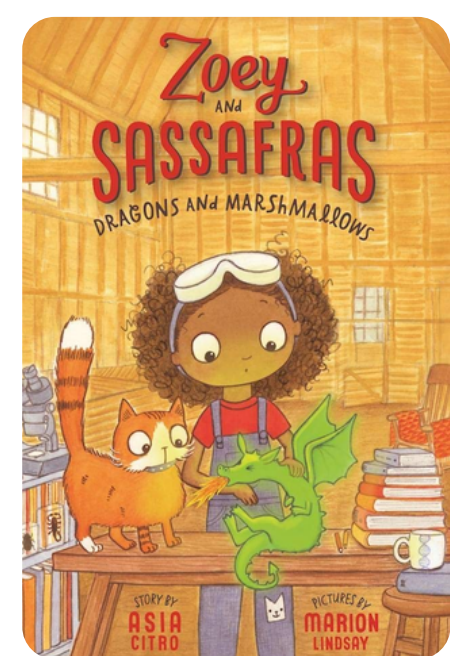
Annie's Life in Lists by Kristin Mahoney

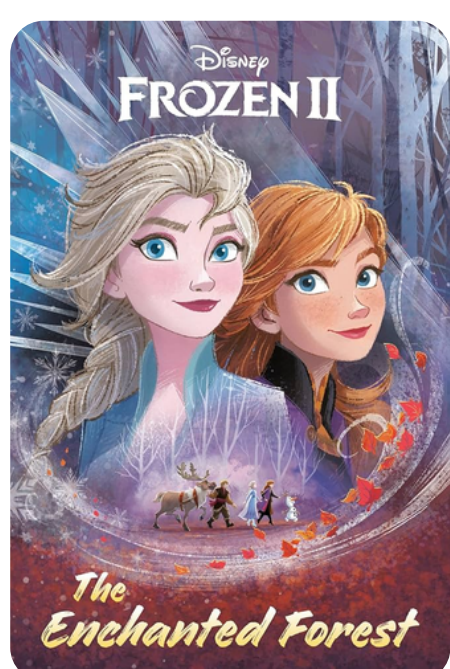
Captain Underpants by Dav Pilkey (Random Book in Series)

The Enchanted Forest by Suzanne Francis

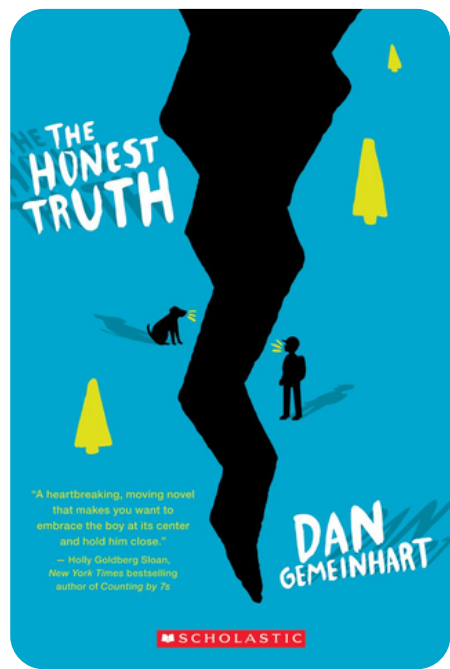

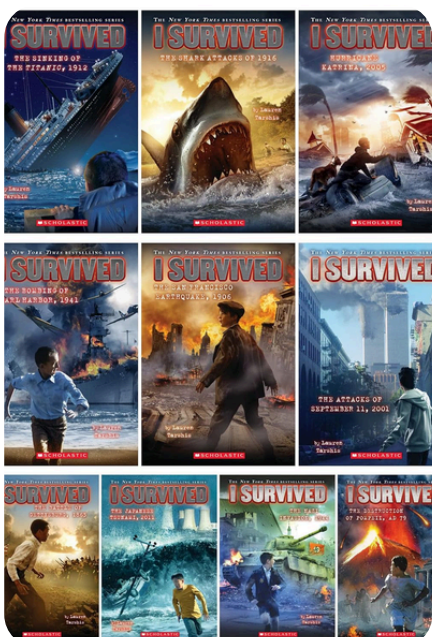
The Honest Truth by Dan Gemeinhart
