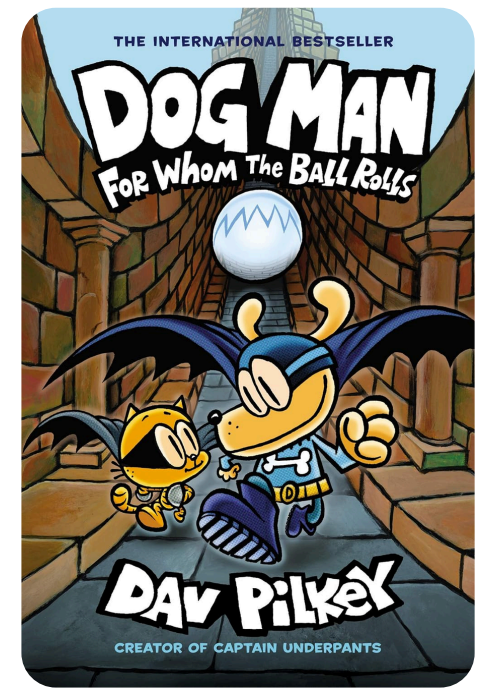

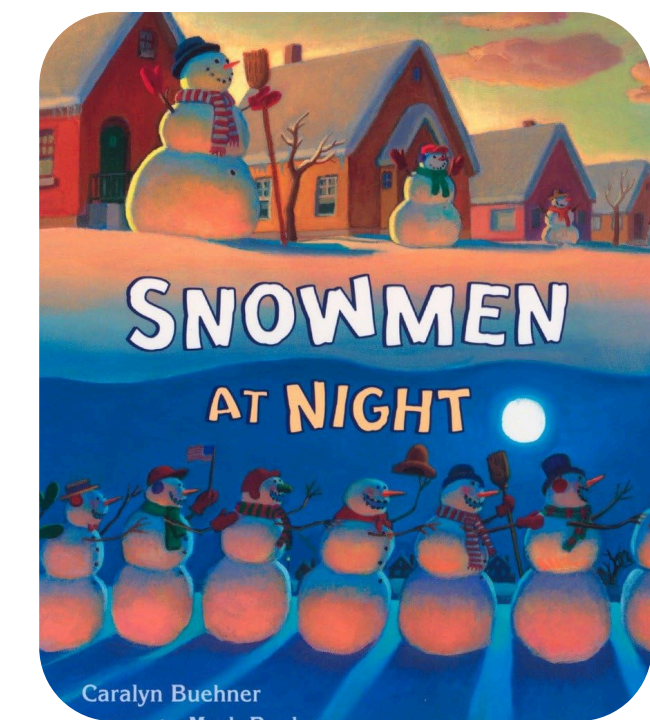
***Dog Man For Whom the Ball Rolls* by Dav Pilkey**

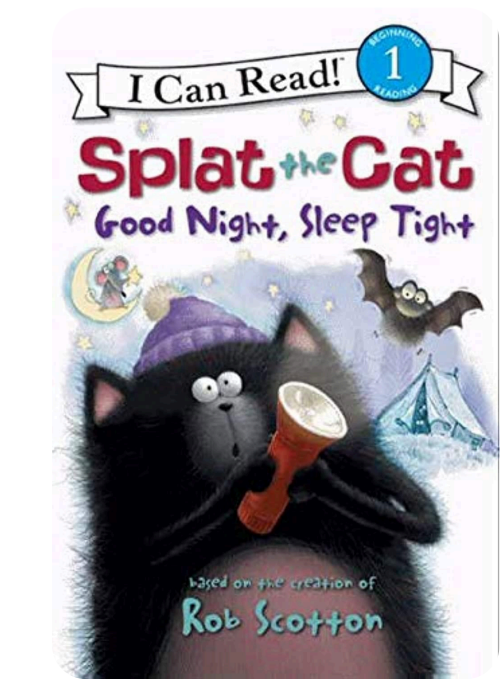
***Snowmen at Night* by Caralyn Buehner**

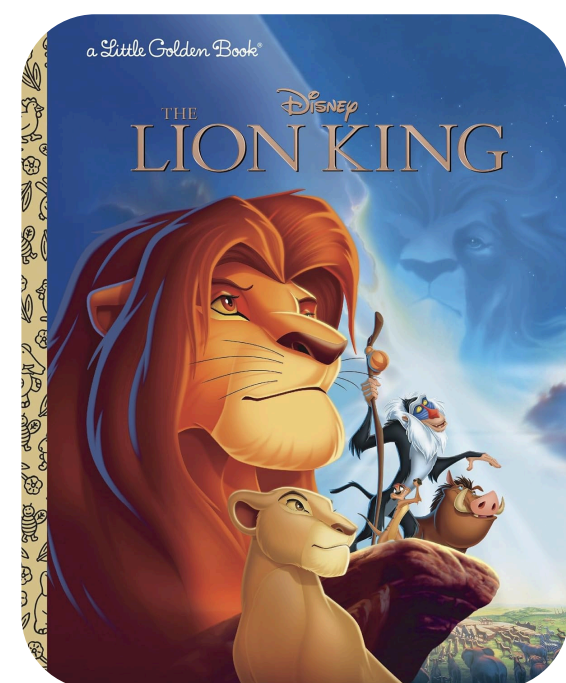
***Splat the Cat: Good Night, Sleep Tight* by Rob Scotton**

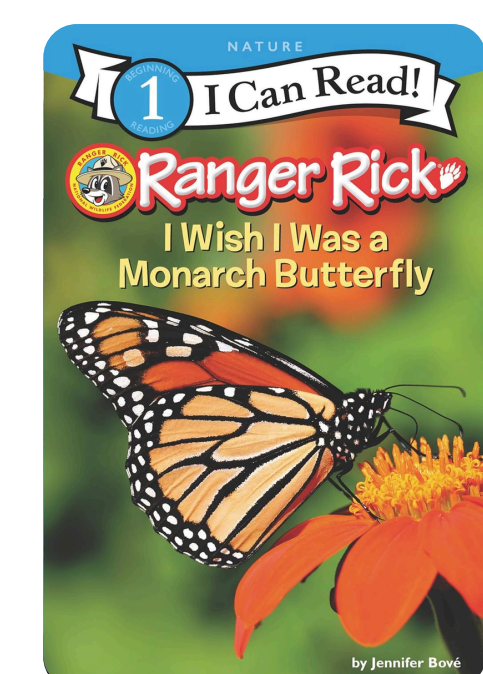
Disney- The Lion King

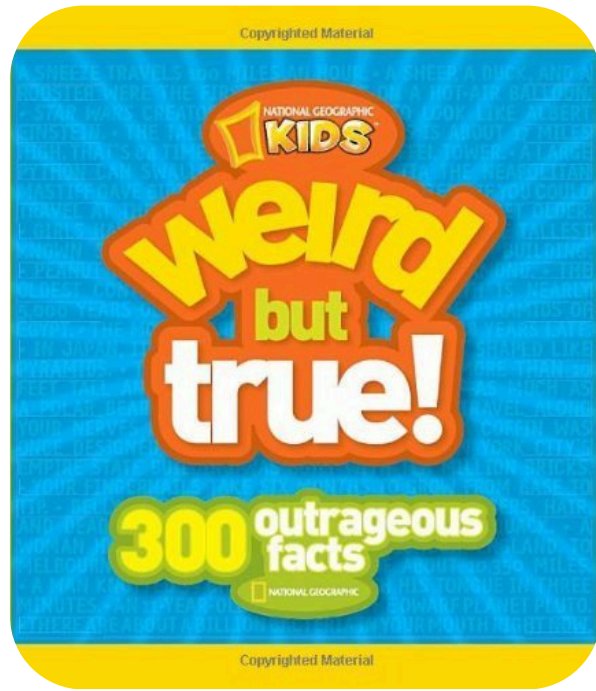
***I Wish I Was a Monarch Butterfly* by Jennifer Bove**

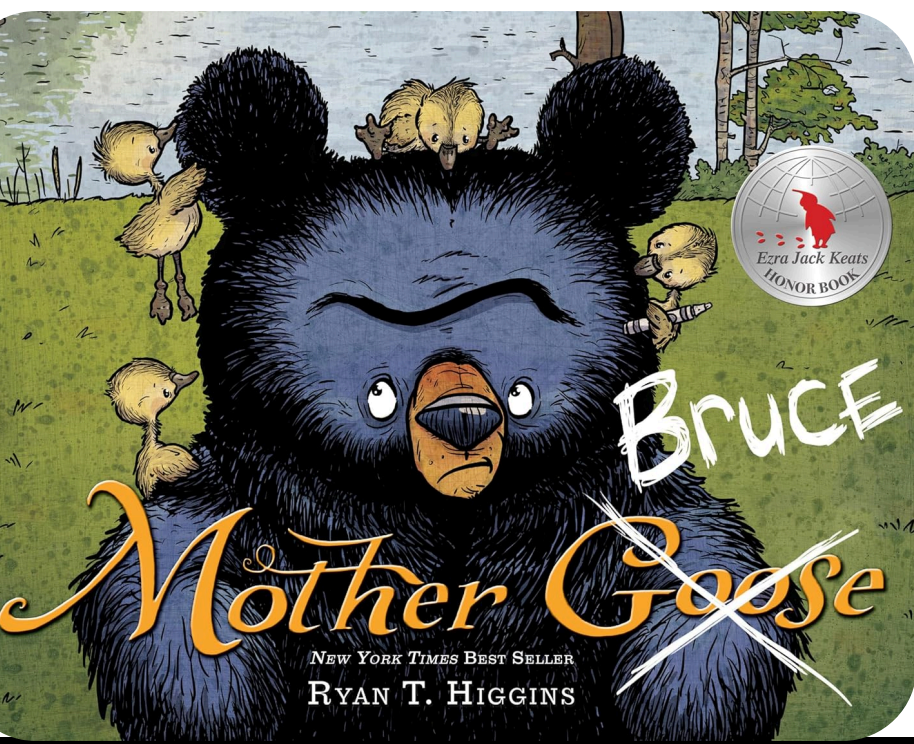

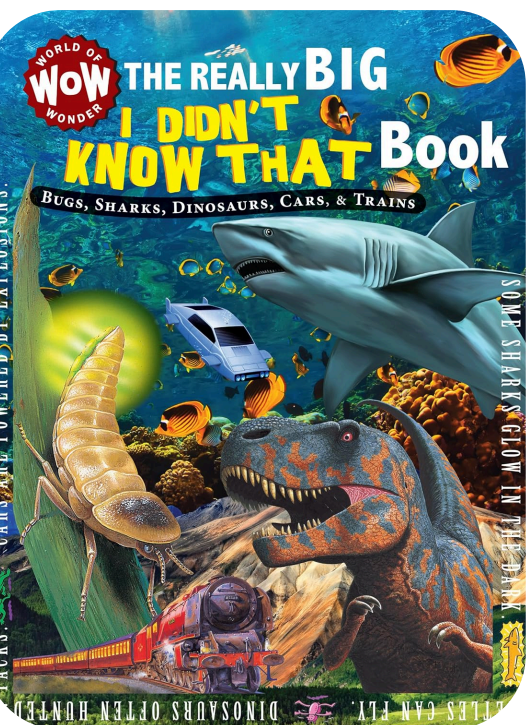
***Picture Book**

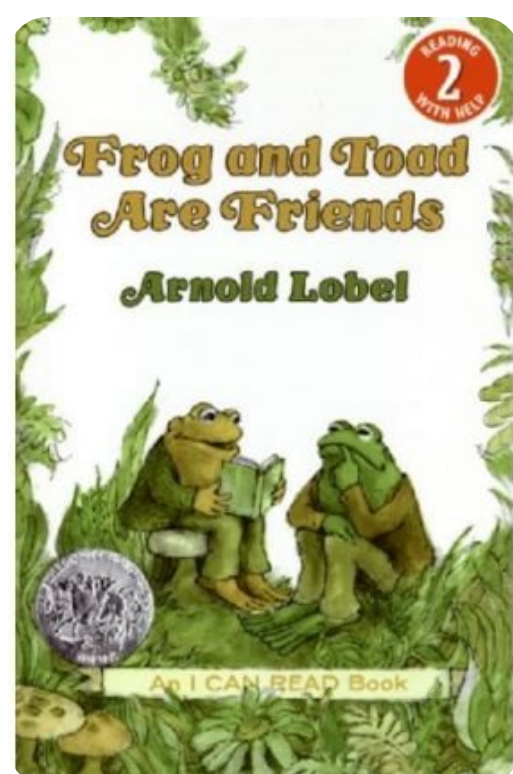

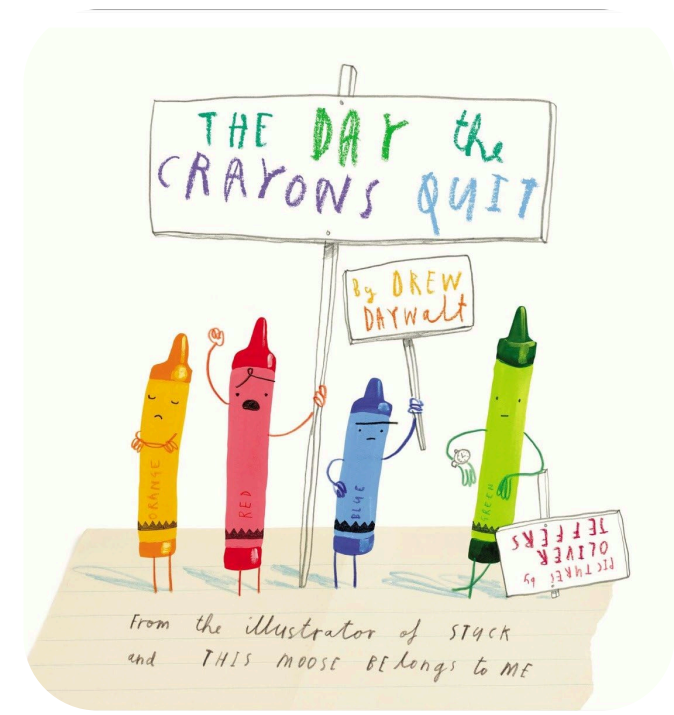

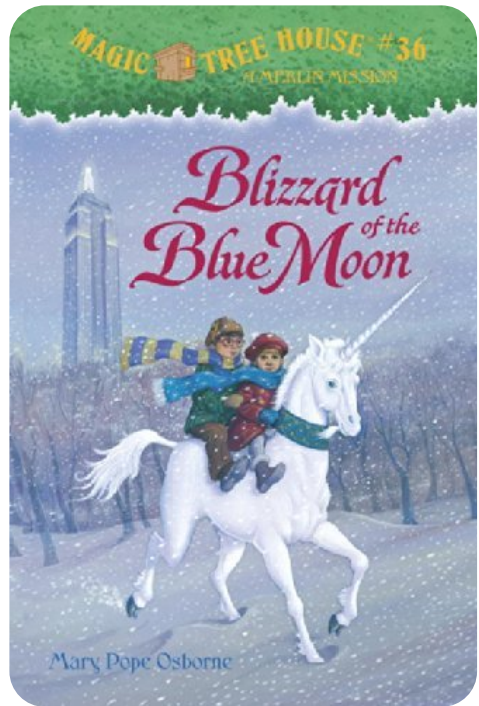

The magic tree house carries Jack and Annie to New York City in 1938 on a mission to rescue the last unicorn during a terrible snow storm.

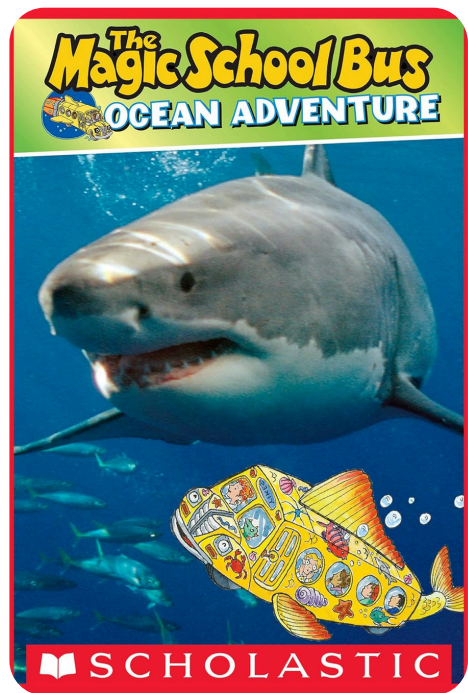

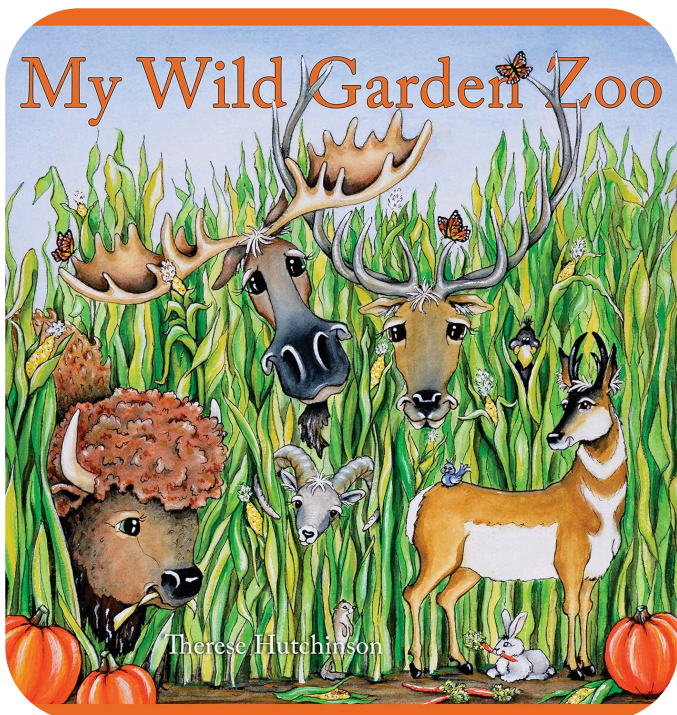
Where's Waldo Now? by Martin Handford

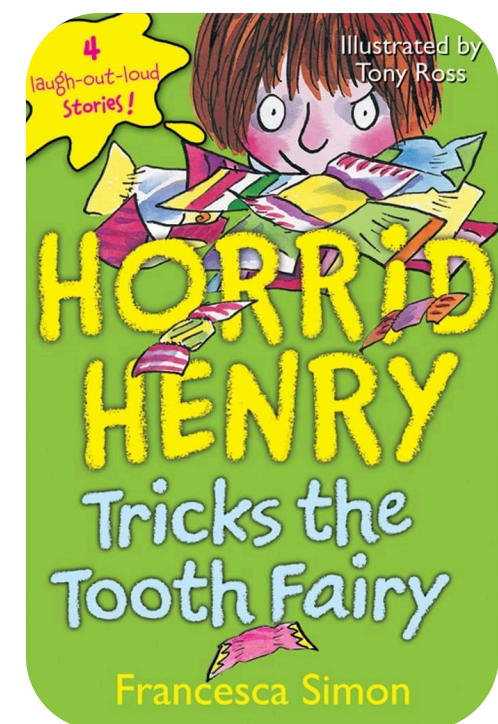

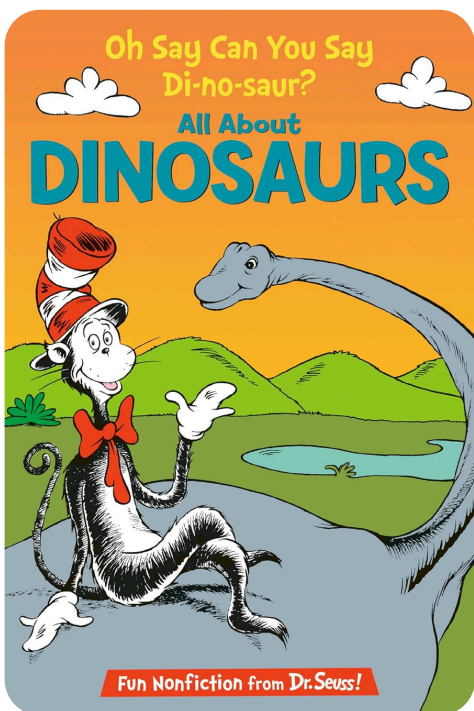

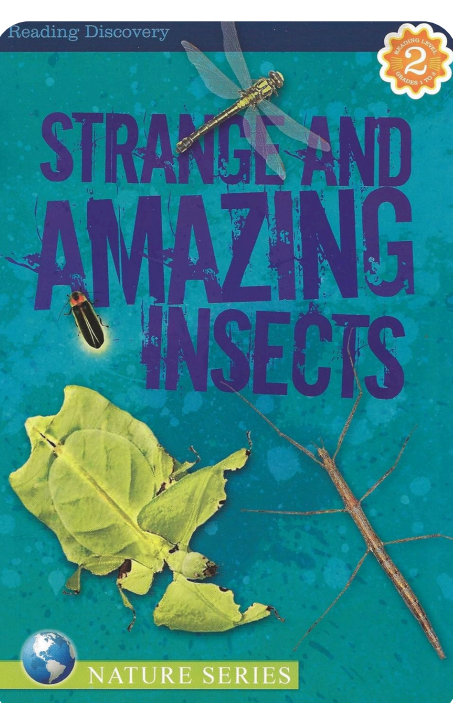
