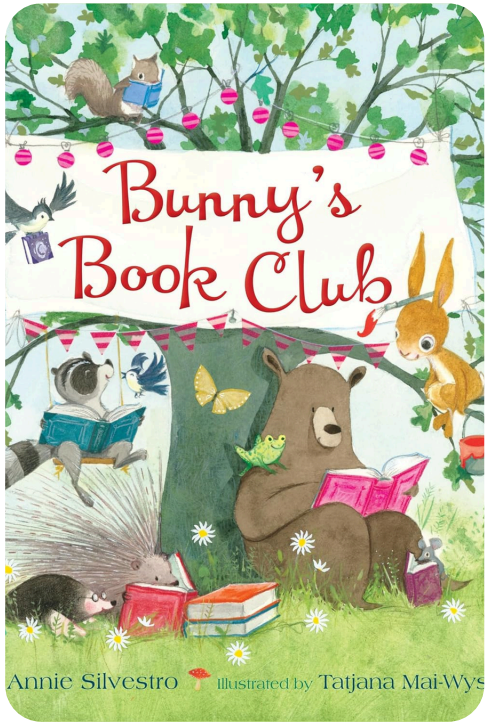
The Knight at Dawn (Book 2) by Mary Pope Osborne

Ella Mentry School's security guard proves overzealous in his pursuit of a peanut-butter-and-jelly-sandwich thief.

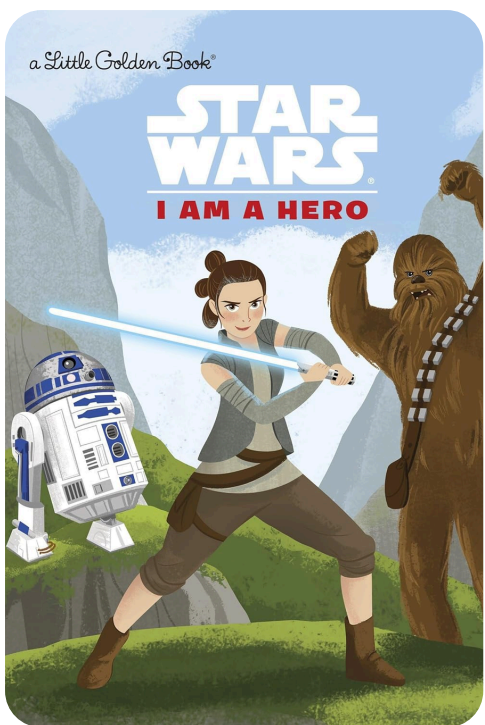

Listening with My Heart reminds us of the other golden rule--to treat ourselves like we would treat a friend. When we do this, we are practicing self-compassion

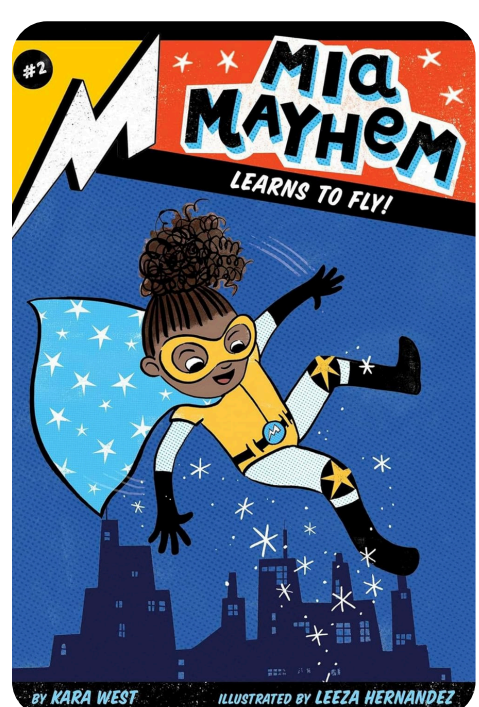

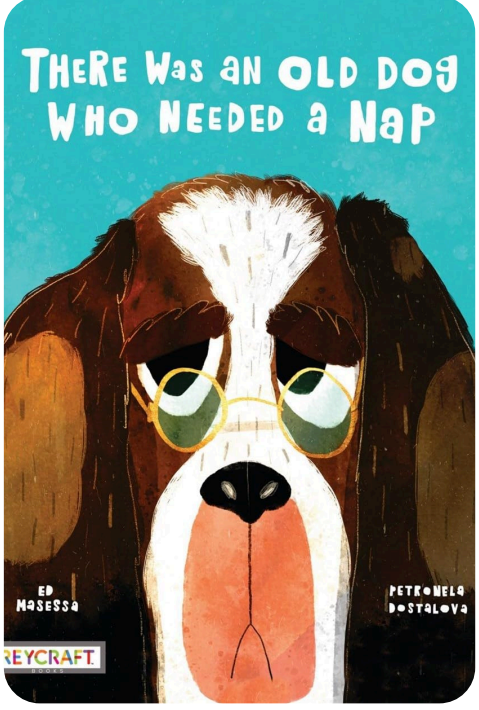
***Mia Mayhem Learns to Fly! (2)* by Kara West**

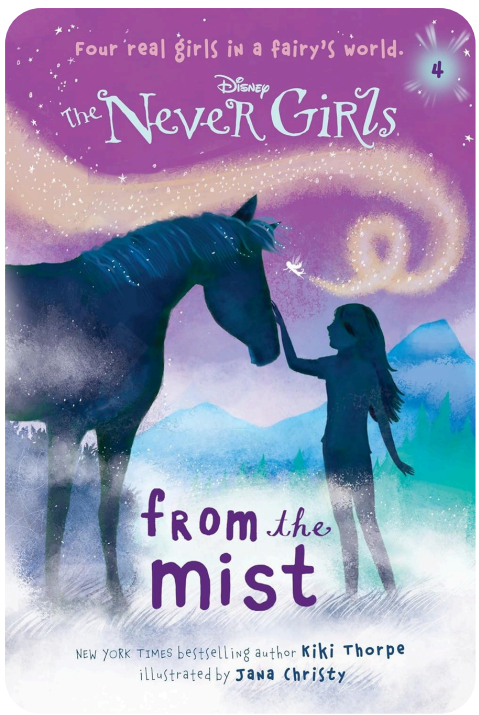

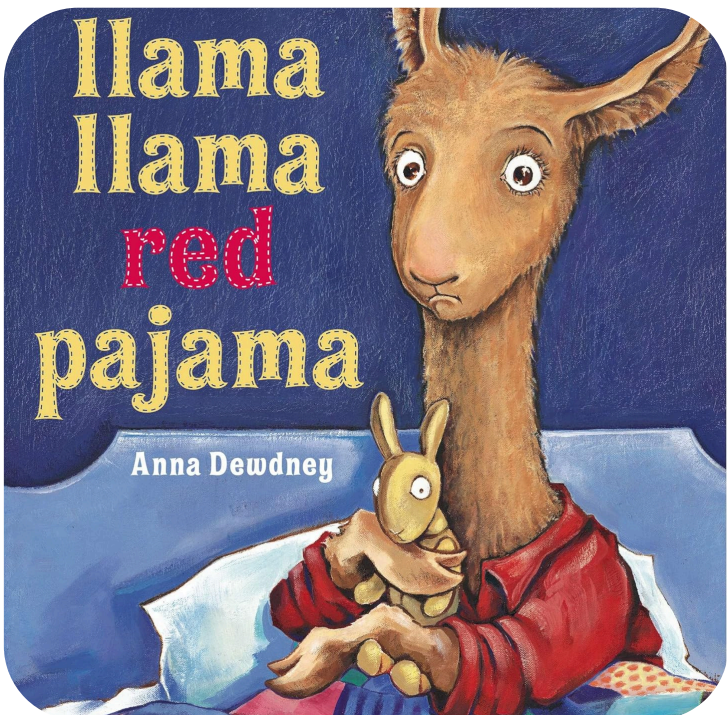

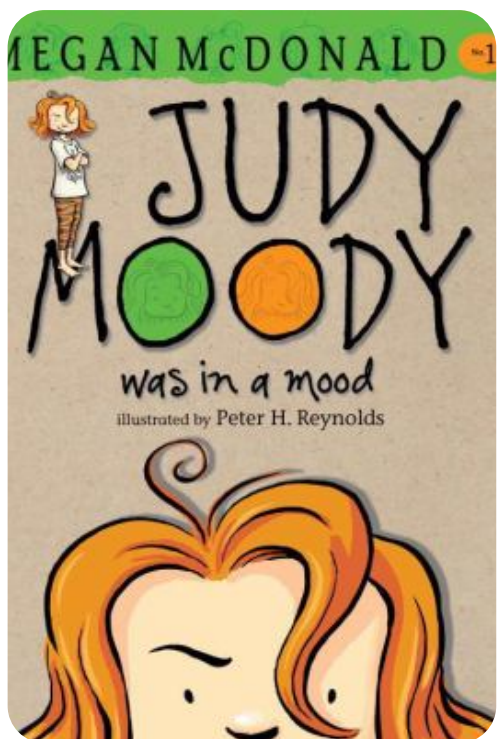

Llama Llama's tale of nighttime drama has charmed readers for over a decade and makes an ideal story for bedtime reading.

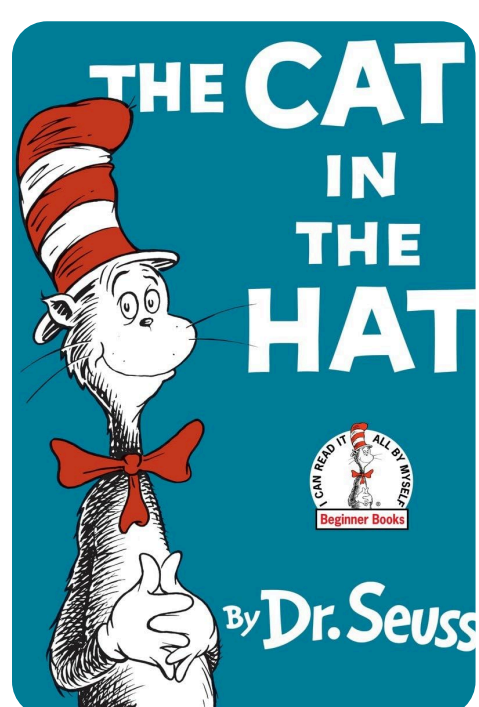
