



JANUARY CHILDREN'S BOOK CHOICES




***The Little Prince* by Antoine de Saint-Exupéry**

Now, with the restored original artwork, the beloved classic story of a young prince's travels throughout space is a profound tale about loneliness and loss, as well as love and friendship.



Purrmmaids: The Scaredy Cat by S. Bardhan- Quallen






Dragons and Marshmallows by Asia Citro




The Hello, Goodbye Window by N. Juster and C. Raschka




Bad Kitty School Daze by Nick Bruel
